SCHOOL GROUP SAILING ACTIVITIES

STUDENTS WITHOUT A PROPERLY COMPLETED ENROLMENT FORM OR WHO ARRIVE WITHOUT THE REQUIRED CLOTHING ARE NOT PERMITTED TO PARTICIPATE IN SAILING ACTIVITIES.

This form is for the students who are enrolled with a school group to attend sailing activities at Northside Sailing School. It must be completed and signed by a parent or legal guardian and then returned to the supervising teacher at school. Students who have not returned this form completed will not be allowed to participate. Students enrolling for non-school activities should contact us for the appropriate form.

The top portion of this form provides some general information about our sailing program. If you have any further questions, please do not hesitate to call our office.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

We use a range of boats including the RS Feva, Laser Radial/4.7, Stretched Laser, RS Vision, Envy and X3. The sailing is conducted by experienced instructors who provide basic lessons for beginners and also help experienced sailors fine tune their skills. Where possible we get the experienced sailors to help teach the beginners. Students are provided with PFDs (life jackets) which they are required to wear, and a rescue boat is with the fleet at all times.

SUITABLE CLOTHING ***PLEASE NOTE THAT 'CROC' STYLE SHOES AND THONGS ARE NOT SUITABLE FOR THESE ACTIVITIES***

Students who arrive for any lessons without all the required clothing may not be allowed to participate in our activities.

Those students who have wetsuits should bring them along. Otherwise wear shorts and t-shirt and bring warm fleece or woollen jumper as well. Bear in mind that sailing is essentially a swimming activity, so any clothing must be able to go in the water. A towel, change of clothes and a plastic bag for the wet clothes are also essential. Suitable footwear is compulsory. Wetsuit booties are the most suitable, or you can wear old sports shoes or 'reef' style sandals. They must fit securely or they will fall off while in the water. A suitable hat is also essential.

PHOTOGRAPHS

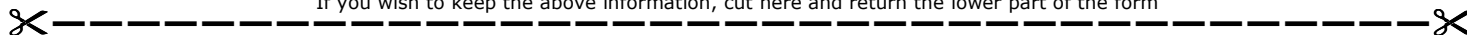
Students are regularly photographed while participating in sailing activities. These photos may be used in our website and in other printed media. Where a photo is used in this way, prints will be made available to you on request where possible.

SCHOOL GROUPS For the safety and enjoyment of all students, we must strictly enforce the following rules. Penalties for breaking the rules may include being banned from sailing for anywhere from a few minutes to the remainder of the term. If this happens there will be no refund of fees.

- *** 1. Shoes must be worn at all times. Students without suitable shoes will not be permitted to sail***
- 2. No running at any time
- 3. Do not leave the rigging area for any reason without permission
- 4. Do not launch the boats until told to do so
- 5. remain inside the designated sailing area during the activities
- 6. Immediately follow all instructions given by Northside staff or other supervising personnel
- 7. Use common sense to control the boat in a safe manner
- 8. Do not swim from the beach or jump off the boats unless told to do so
- 9. Do not pick up or throw sand
- 10. All students must pitch in to do their fair share of setting up and packing up the equipment
- 11. Be polite and respectful to all students and staff members

Normal school rules apply while attending Northside Sailing School, and your school's disciplinary system may be used when necessary
